- 1. SUPPORT DRIVE Budget \$8,000 vs. Actual to date \$8,576
- 2. MEADOW FARMS FUNDRAISER Budget \$10,000 vs Actual Profit \$11,237.56
 - Sales results from MF total sales: \$27,066.50
- 3. GIFT CARDS Budget \$5,000 vs Actual Profit (R1 and R2) \$5,667
 - Total Sales/Profit \$84,852/\$5,667 vs Last year \$85,780/\$5,557.80
- 4. SKI & SKATE Budget \$13,000 vs Estimated Actual Profit \$18,500
