2025/26 BUDGET - Review and Approve

Almost \$10K of ORK/AIR was not used.

- Need to encourage schools to use their funds, as opposed to waiting for priorities money. Helps us track how funds are used.
- Schools would like more flexibility on using ORK/AIR funds
