## BUDGET:

- Reimbursements - Reminder to get in all reimbursements from 2025 submitted to the Treasurer.  
Partnership with School Board on priorities (lower priorities so we can get a bigger surplus) - they can let us know some things that might be needed in the district. It's a way to prioritize things since they know what is going on at all the schools. Generally, the schools are not pre-planning for these costs. Allows us to pre-plan about what we might use the surplus.  
Agreed we should set a minimum of \$1,500 per school?
- Potential Budget updates - **VOTE NEEDED**-Change standing rules to \$1,500 for priorities- Board approved

  - Volunteering at School Concession Stands for Better Visibility – Logistics could be tough, need to get more information about the process and then gauge interest for volunteers
